**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
APPEAL AGAINST REFUSAL OF PLANNING PERMISSION**

I write to inform you that The Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government (through the Planning Inspectorate), has received an appeal from M Gore & D Fisher & S Fisher against the Council's refusal to grant planning permission for Proposed 3 no dwellings with garages, access, drives/turning & parking spaces - revised scheme to 14/00299/FUL at Land Opposite The Orchard & Lamorns, Dixton Road, Alstone, Tewkesbury, Gloucestershire, . The appeal is to be decided by an exchange of written statements from the parties followed by an Inspector's site visit. As a consultee or person who made comments upon the planning application, you may take part in the process as follows:-

- Any comments that you sent to the Council regarding application for planning permission will be forwarded to the Planning Inspectorate and copied to the appellant. The Inspector in deciding the appeal will take these comments into account.

- Any additional or modified comments you may wish to make must be sent directly to the Planning Inspectorate, Room 3/10a, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6PN, quoting their reference APP/G1630/W/15/3133840. **You should send 3 copies of your comments to the Planning Inspectorate to arrive within five weeks of the appeal start date 10.09.2015. Any comments received after the deadline will not normally be seen and will be returned to you.**
